**Arrival – Volunteers should arrive **Friday, July 7, 2023, 9:00 am** (unless otherwise instructed)**

- Indicate your arrival information on application and inform us of any changes
- Check in at Headquarters when you arrive for registration

**MDO may conduct background screening on ALL Volunteers, as the Board deems necessary**

- Each situation will be evaluated individually and ALL information will be treated confidentially

**Parking – Plenty of free parking on school grounds**

- Speed limit (5 mph) STRICTLY enforced - \*\*\*MDO accepts NO responsibility for tickets on campgrounds

**Volunteers bringing Participants**

- Participants remain your responsibility until registration on Sunday, July 9
- Volunteers bringing Participants will rotate childcare in order to attend mandatory training

**Committee Assignment**

- You may be assigned to more than one committee
- Directors will make final determination based on your availability and qualifications

**First Aid / CPR / Nursing / EMT / Lifeguard Certification / Interpreter / ServSafe Certification**

- If you have medical training and are willing to offer your services, please indicate on your application

**Electronic Devices**

- The use of cell phones, pagers or other electronic devices is strictly prohibited during MDO
- Only Authorized **Volunteers** may use devices **ONLY** for communication related to MDO
- Please exercise restraint and do not use cell phones or other devices when on duty
- **MDO accepts NO responsibility for loss or damage to ANY personal property brought to MDO.**
- **Participants** are not allowed to use electronic devices **AT ANY TIME**
