Arrival – Volunteers should arrive Friday, July 11, 2023, 9:00 am (unless otherwise instructed)

- Indicate your arrival information on application and inform us of any changes
- Check in at Headquarters when you arrive for registration
- MDO may conduct background screening on ALL Volunteers, as the Board deems necessary
 - Each situation will be evaluated individually and ALL information will be treated confidentially

Volunteers bringing Participants

- Participants remain your responsibility until registration on Sunday, July 13
- Volunteers bringing Participants will rotate childcare in order to attend mandatory training
